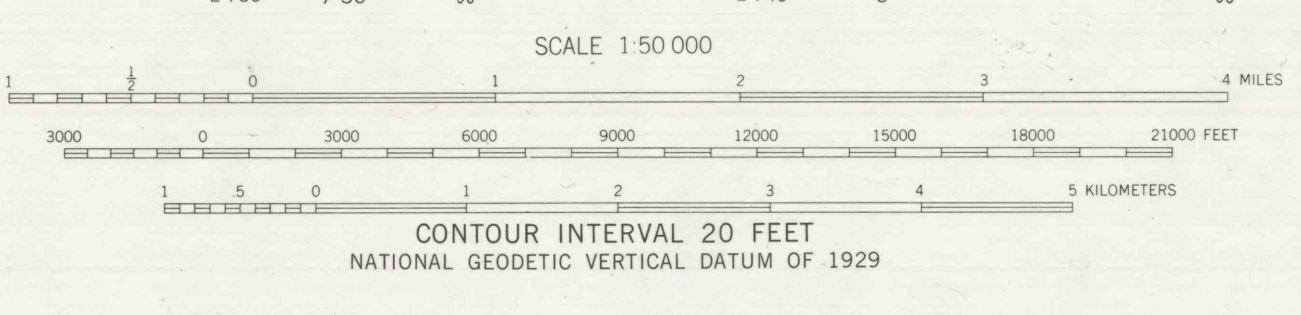
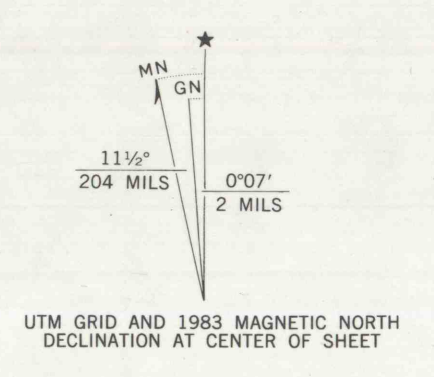


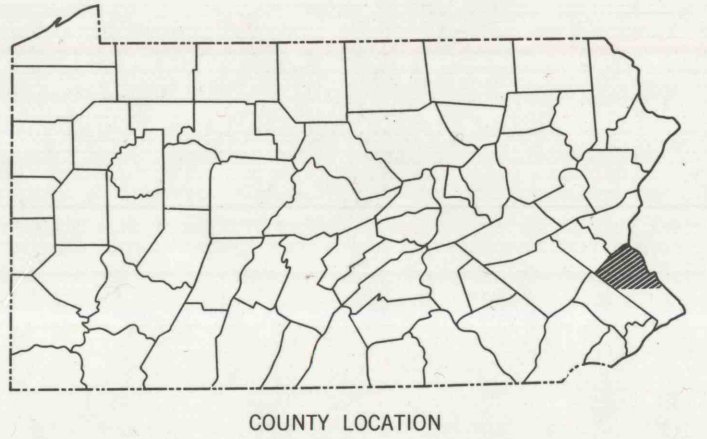
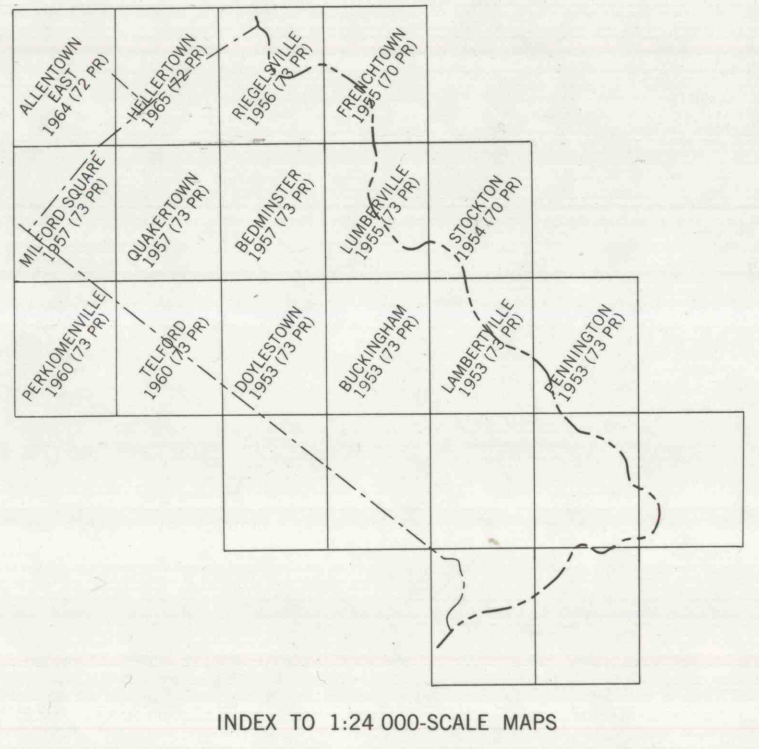


3 = Level III - Highest Radon Risk Areas
