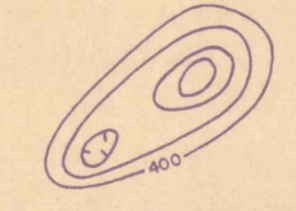


Aeromagnetic survey flown by AIRMAG SURVEYS, INC.

EXPLANATION



Magnetic contours
Contours show the reduced total magnetic field intensity derived from the total magnetic field with the Epoch 1965.0 international geomagnetic reference field (Ref. *Grid Values of Total Magnetic Intensity IGRF-1965* by E. B. Fabiano and N.W. Padden, Coast and Geodetic Survey Technical Report No. 38, 55p, 1969) removed. Hachured to indicate closed areas of lower magnetic intensity. Contour intervals 10 and 50 gammas.
