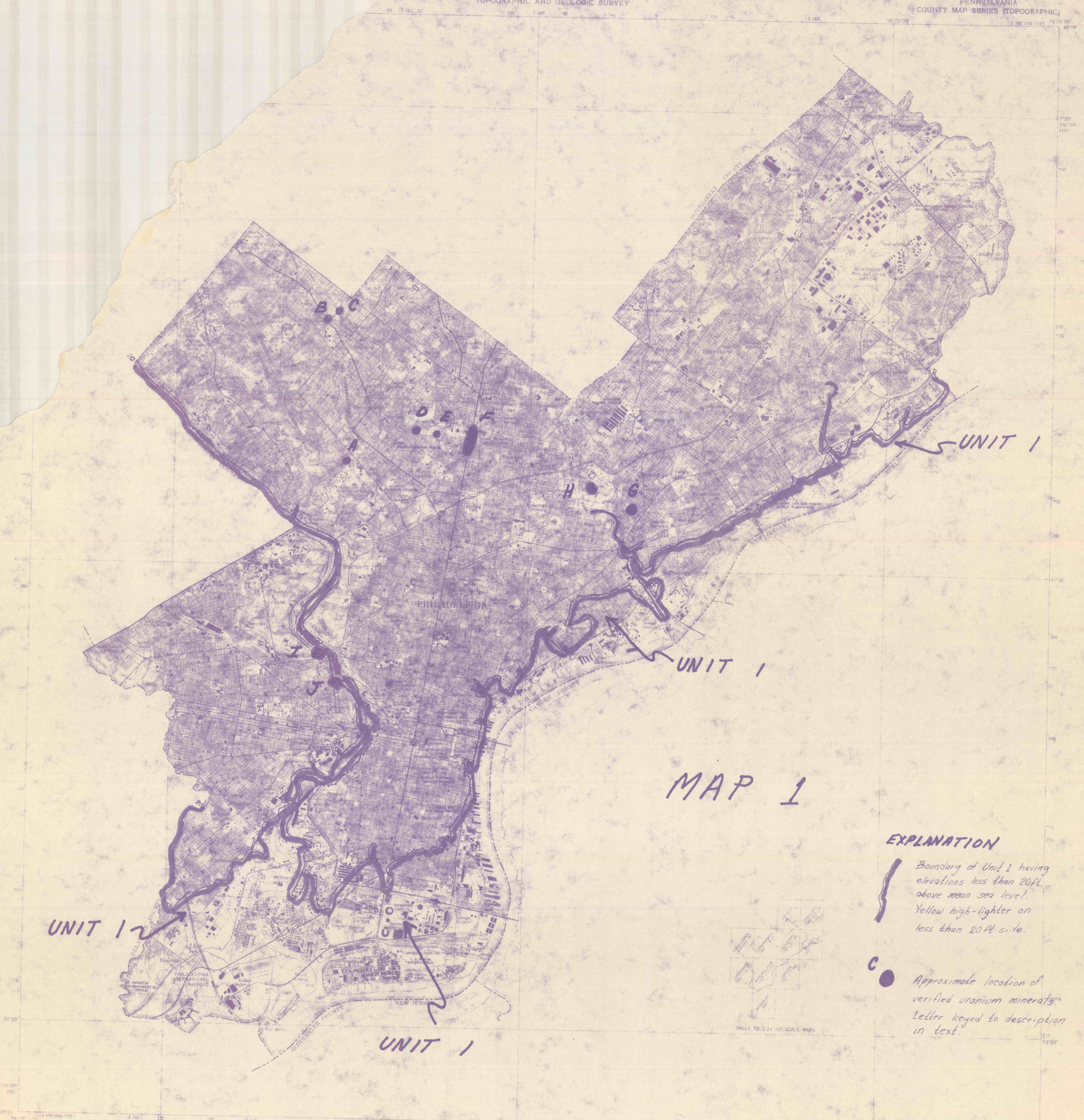

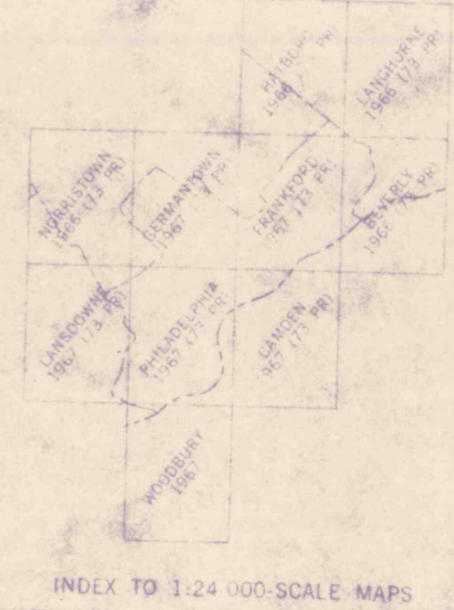

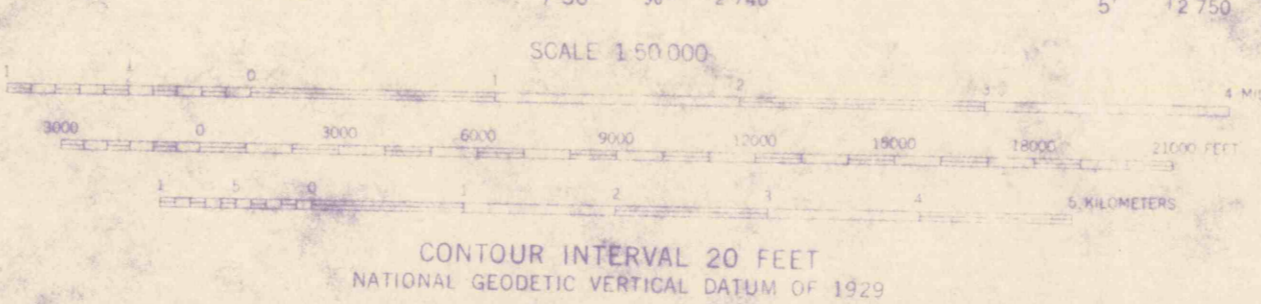
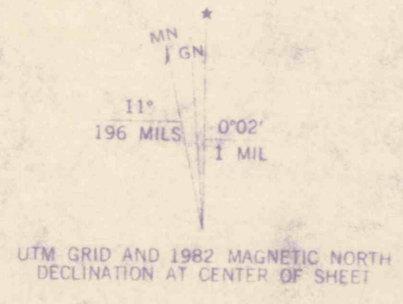
 Boundary of Unit 1 having elevations less than 20 ft above mean sea level. Yellow high-lighter on less than 20 ft side.

 Approximate location of verified uranium minerals. Letter keyed to description in text.



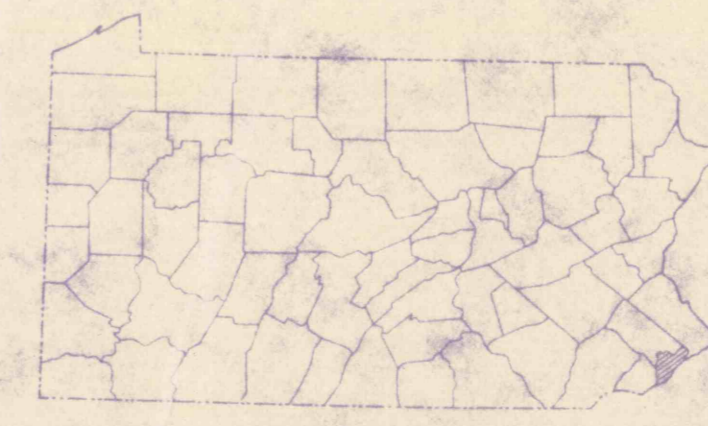
