



**NOTES:**

TYPICALLY, PROPOSED ACCESS ROADS WILL BE SLOPED AND DITCHED TO DIRECT WATER TO ONE SIDE OF THE ROAD AND THIS DRAINAGE WILL PASS THROUGH TO THE DOWNSLOPE SIDE OF THE ROAD. SEDIMENT FENCE OR HAY BALES WILL BE PLACED DOWNSLOPE OF ANY PORTION OF A CONSTRUCTED ROAD AS NECESSARY.

THE PERMIT BOUNDARY FOR EACH BOREHOLE SITE IS LIMITED TO THE PROPOSED ACCESS ROAD AND ENOUGH AREA AROUND THE BOREHOLE TO ALLOW A DRILL RIG TO SET UP. A TEMPORARY CUTTINGS PIT IS PROVIDED DURING BOREHOLE DRILLING OPERATIONS.

PERMANENT VEGETATION FOR THE DISTURBED AREA WITHIN THE PERMIT BOUNDARY WILL BE AS NOTED IN MODULE 20.5(b).

UPON MINE CLOSURE RECLAMATION ACTIVITIES WILL RETURN THE SITE TO THE APPROXIMATE ORIGINAL CONTOURS.
