



THE POLAND MINE RESOURCES, INC., RESIDUAL WASTE DISPOSAL FACILITIES HAVE BEEN DESIGNED TO INCORPORATE THE STATE OF THE ART DISPOSAL TECHNIQUES AND ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROL PRACTICES FOR FLY ASH DISPOSAL AND HAS BEEN APPROVED BY THE PENNSYLVANIA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES AS WELL AS THE U.S. ARMY CORP OF ENGINEERS. THE BARGE UNLOADING FACILITY IS SITUATED ON THE WEST BANK OF THE MONONGAHELA RIVER AT MILE POST 86.5 APPROXIMATELY TWO MILES SOUTH OF LOCK AND DAM #7 AND 1/2 MILE NORTH OF THE CONFLUENCE OF DUNKARD CREEK IN GREENE COUNTY. THIS ILLUSTRATIVE DEPICTS DEVELOPMENT APPROXIMATELY 10 YEARS INTO CONSTRUCTION.
