GREEN - COAL PURCHASED BY THE COMMONWEALTH SINCE 1923.

100' outside beam excavation for lateral support with at least 50% of beam remaining. 100' inside beam excavation for lateral support. At points of concentrated weight where solid blocks of coal should be left for vertical support, of a size, at least equal to the size of the structure to be supported. In case of steel beams in my opinion there should be a solid block under the steel measured from the center through on a radius of not less than 120 ft.
