



MOSHANNON COLLIERY N^o 33 AND N^o 37

Area shaded in Red was explored by State Mine Inspector William Gandy and G. Resovich Colliery Mine Rescue Teams on February 22, 23, 1926. For missing man Ronald Mack of Patton, Pa. This was requested by Patton Fire Chief Dana Smith. Operations were ceased at 2:00 P.M. 2-23-26, until further notice. No signs of missing man were found.

At approximately 4:30 P.M. February 24, 1924, Alvin Mack, former Colliery and in formed me that the man was found in Chest Creek lifeless 100 yards from his home.
