



Openings 2 - 11m x 7 - x  
one by one -

Upper Drift vein - 4 ft  
Lower Drift vein - 3 ft

On account of poor roof rock on all the  
upper vein of coal - Upper Drift vein within the  
yellow line is considered as worked out with  
the exception of the coal left in the pillars in  
the haulage way - about 10 acres

Holdings. Within blue line - Coal owned jointly by  
Jas. H. Corbett and Corbett Coal Co. the latter  
no third interest, purchased September 1919  
Gould Hrs. - lease from Jas. H. Corbett  
with lease of line from above  
Balance within red line - Under lease from  
J. H. Corbett (as above) - Upper Drift vein  
No survey of the lower vein of coal has been made  
but estimated acreage - 697 acres (Jas. H. Corbett and Co.)
