

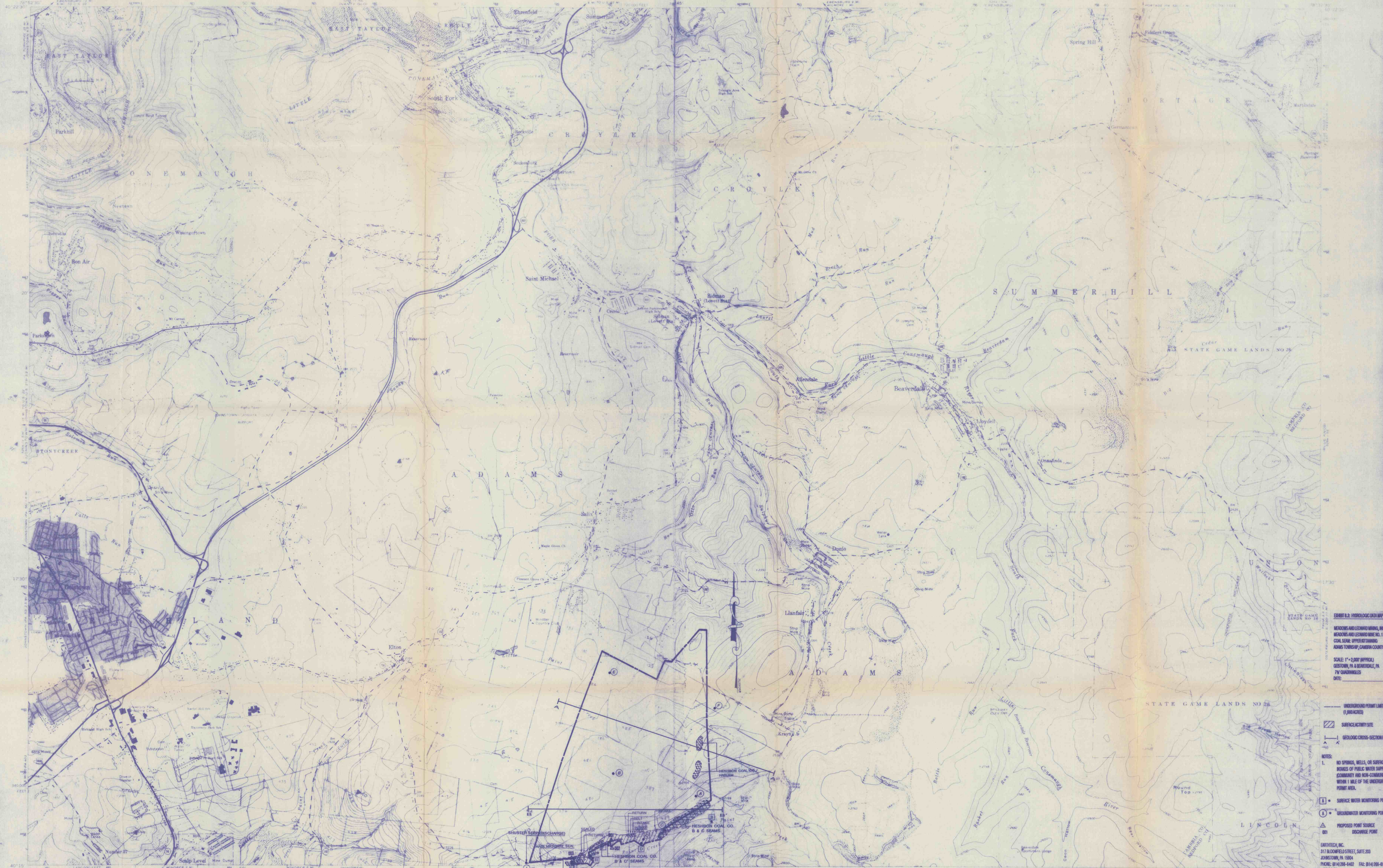


EXHIBIT B: HYDROLOGIC DATA MAP
