Gentlemen:

We are returning our report of coal mined in Elder Township during the year 1928, for which credit is claimed, together with a photograph of a part of the mine print furnished us by the Miller Run Coal Company, Jan. 8, 1929.

On this photograph the notations "Bad roof, no coal", All coal between the red line and crop taken out", and "Mined since map poasted", together with acreages and red line and the extensions of crop lines were on the map furnished us, but did not photograph very well on account of the fact that they were made in red.

As you may note, there remains a total of 21.90 Acres of coal in the George Semelsberger Tract in the parcels A & B - the balance of the tract is below the outcrop.

When we reported this tract originally for taxing purposes, we reported 76 acres of coal, which was very
badly in error. The estimate was based on a fixed map
acquired by us when we acquired the property, and the crop
lines were apparently sketched in without very accurate
data.

We previously reported 4 Acres as mined from this tract and, to be conservative, considered the coal remaining to be 25 acres, and reported the 47 Acres as worked out and unworkable - our reference as to the unworkable coal being to the area beyond the outcrop.

We trust this information will be satisfactory.
