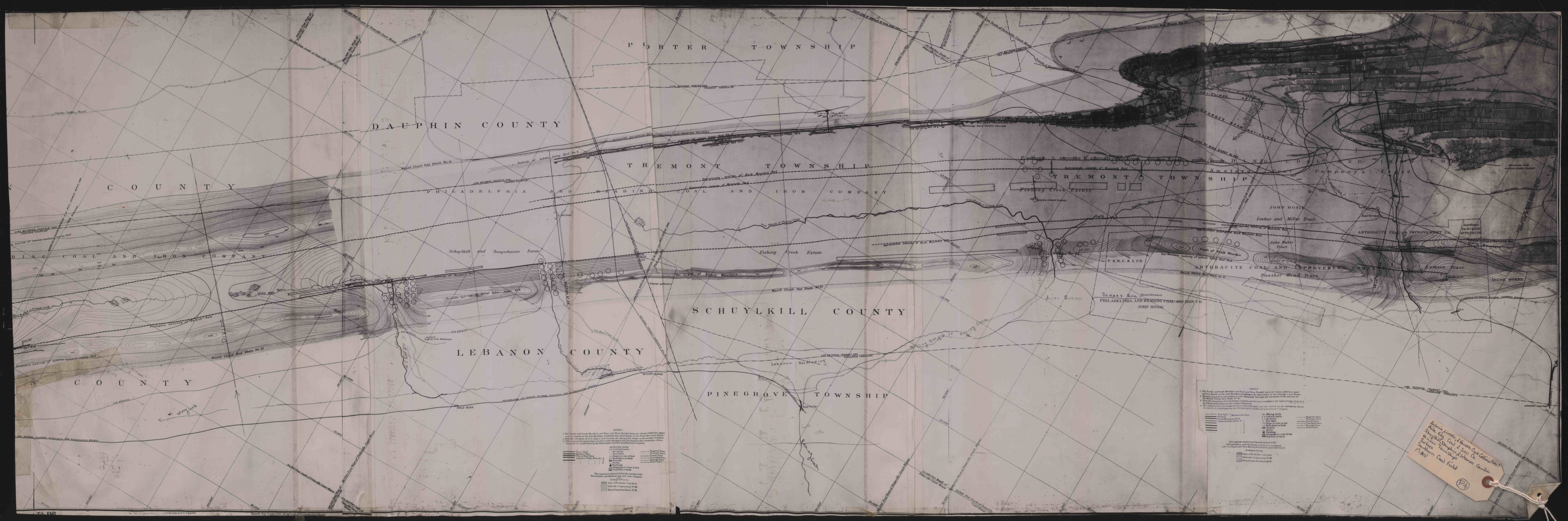




NOTES
