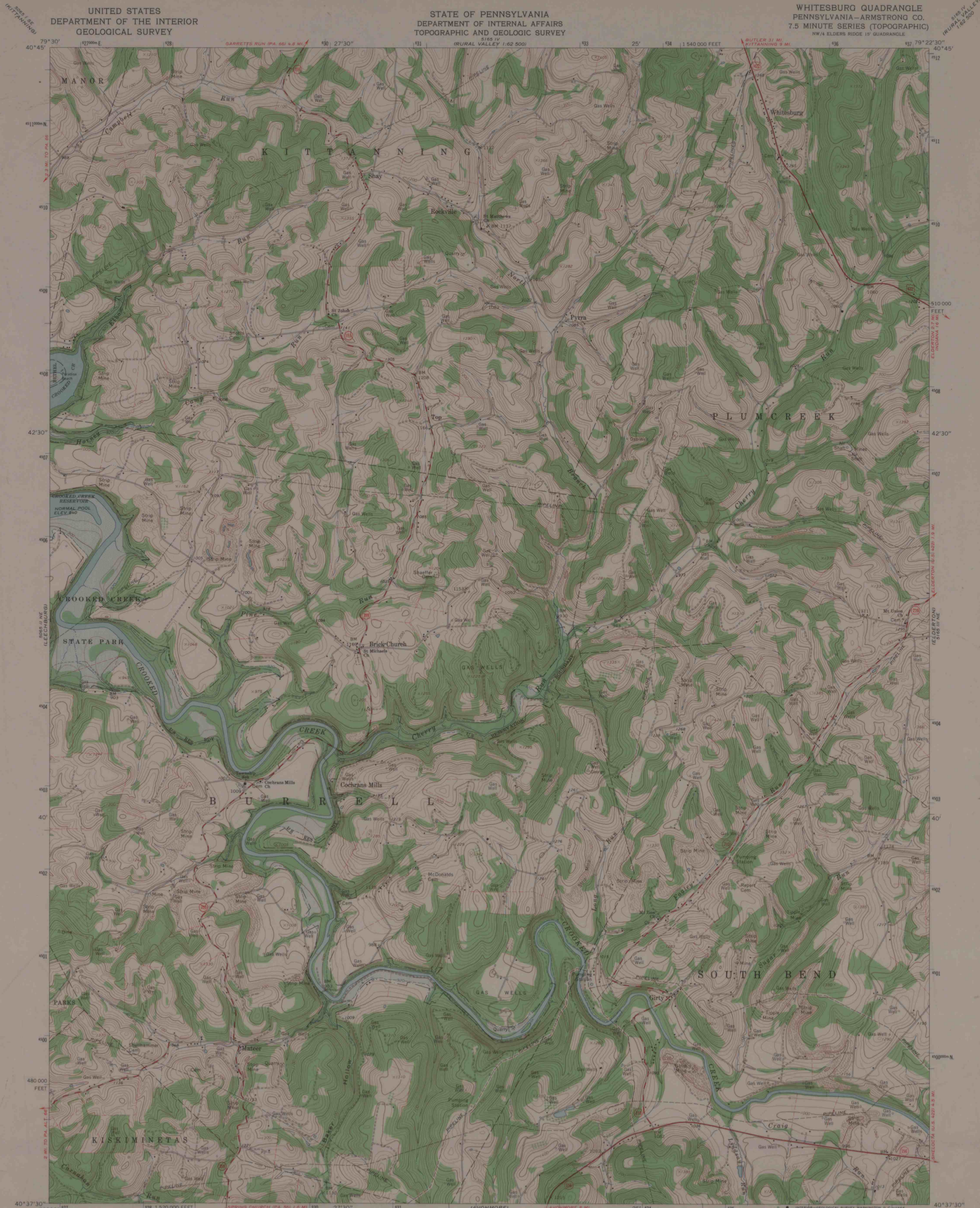

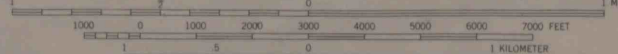
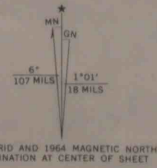
Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum. 10,000-foot grid based on Pennsylvania coordinate system, south zone
