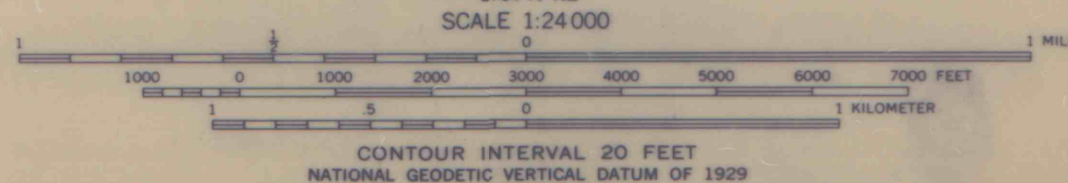
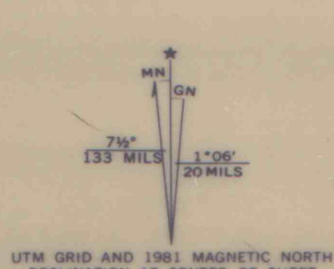

projection lines 4 meters south and 20 meters west as shown by
dashed corner ticks.
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where
generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked.
Area covered by dashed light-blue pattern is subject to controlled
inundation to 975 feet by Conemaugh Dam.
There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of
the National or State reservations shown on this map.
