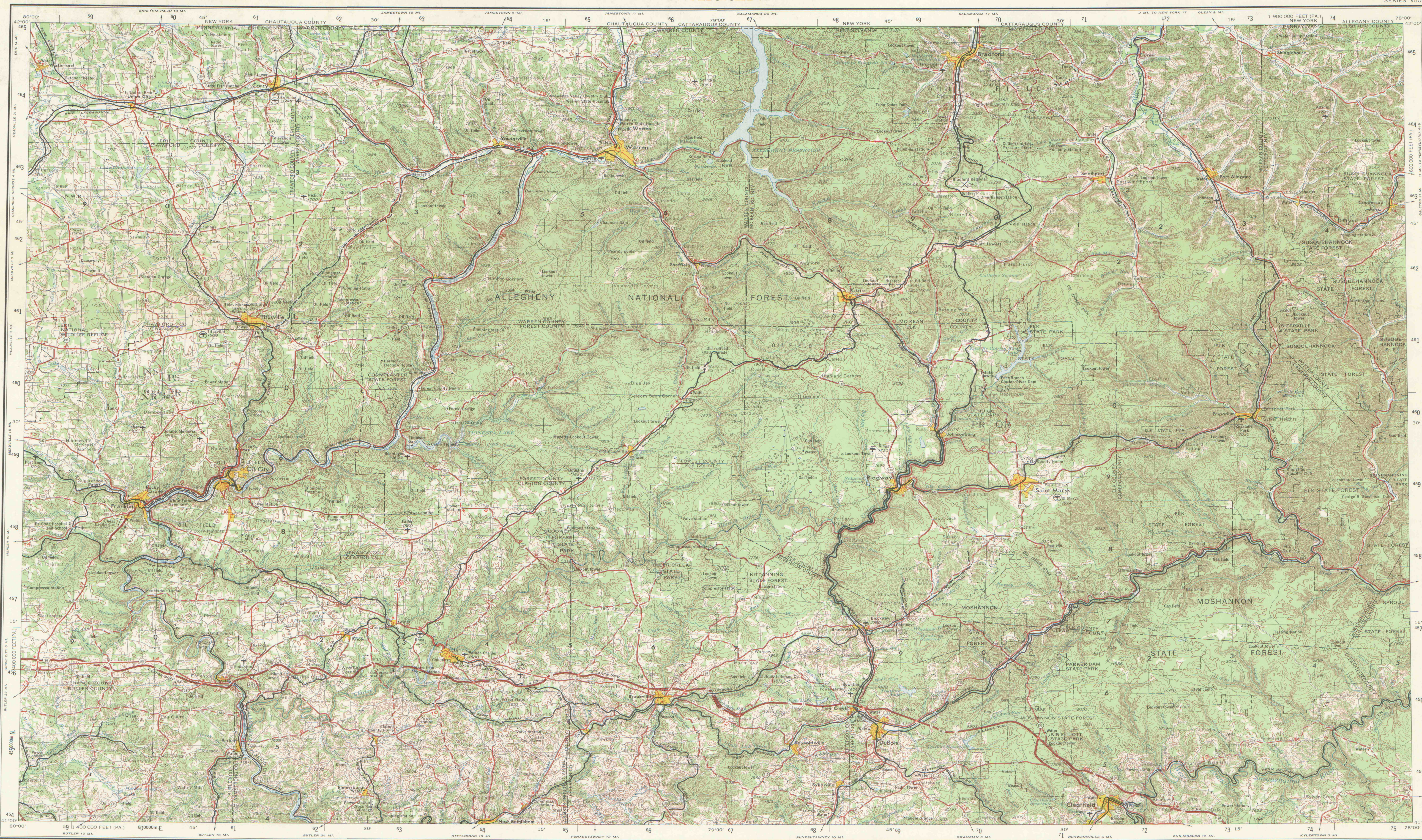

TO ONE A STANDARD REFERENCE ON THIS SHEET TO NEAREST 1000 METERS

SAMPLE POINT: GOAL HILL

1. Read letters identifying 100,000 meter square in which the point lies.
2. Locate first VERTICAL grid line to LEFT of point and read LARGE figure showing margin, or on the line itself.
3. Locate first HORIZONTAL grid line BELOW point and read LARGE figure showing margin, or on the line itself.
Estimate tenths from grid line to point.
