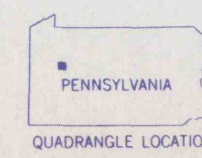
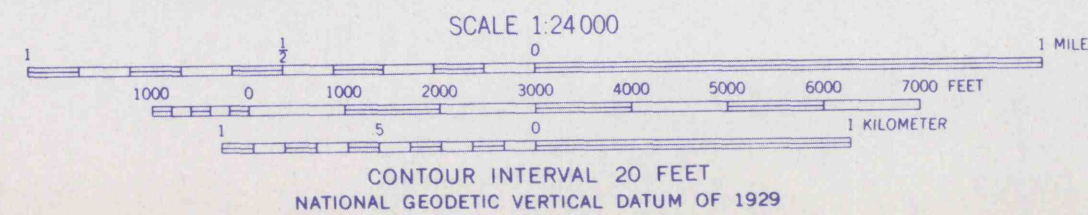
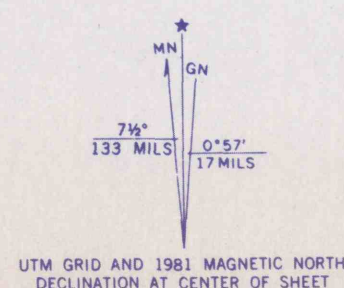

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 3 meters south and 19 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks
