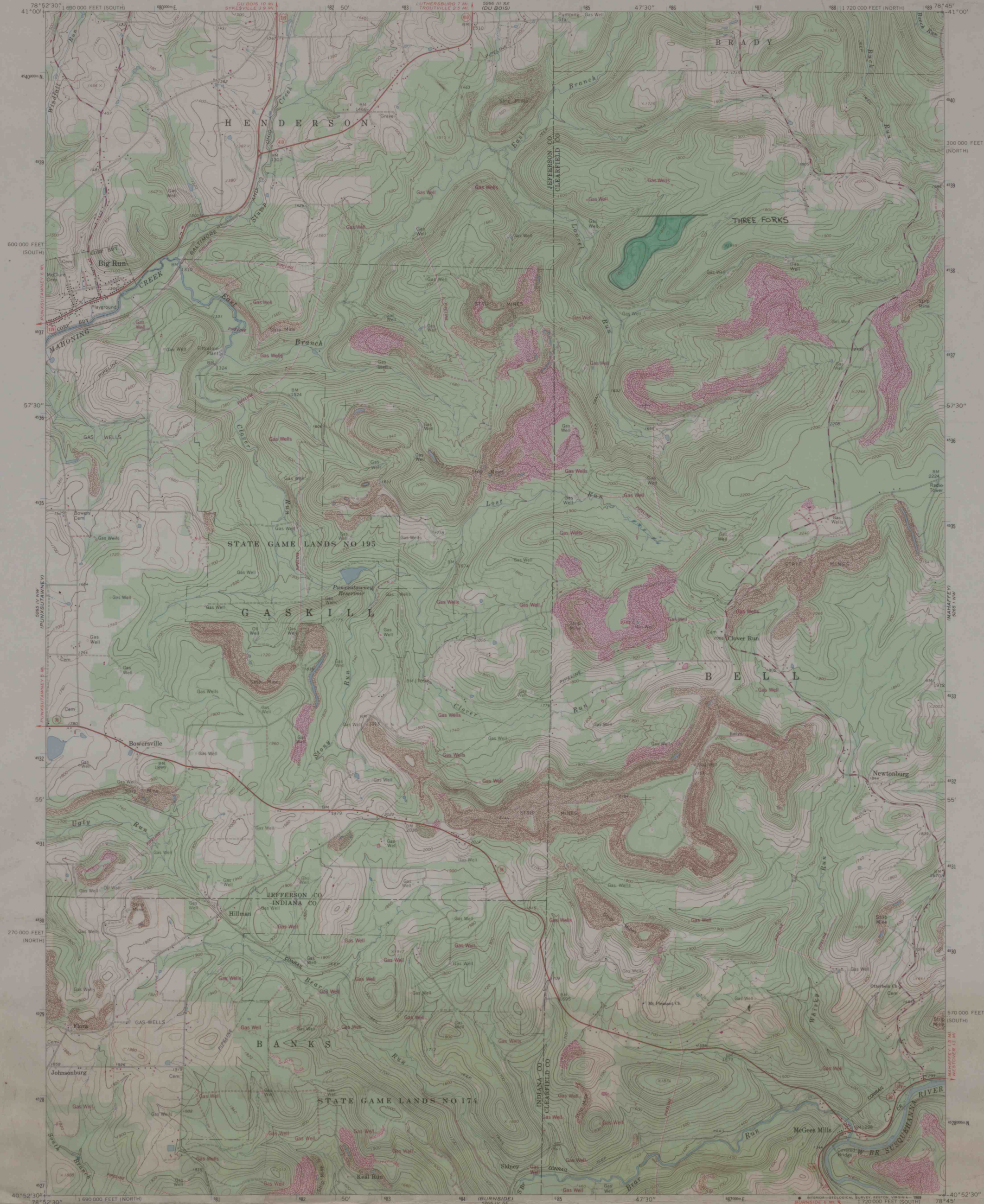

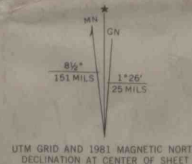
MCGEES MILLS QUADRANGLE

zone 17, shown in blue. 1927 North American Datum.
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983
move the projection lines 4 meters south and
21 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks.

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where
generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked.
There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of
the National or State reservations shown on this map.
