

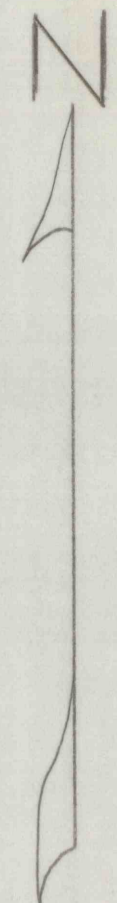
Acreage Estimate

Exact acreage required or desired will depend upon size of range facilities and may also be influenced by construction requirements and other range-associated land use proposals.

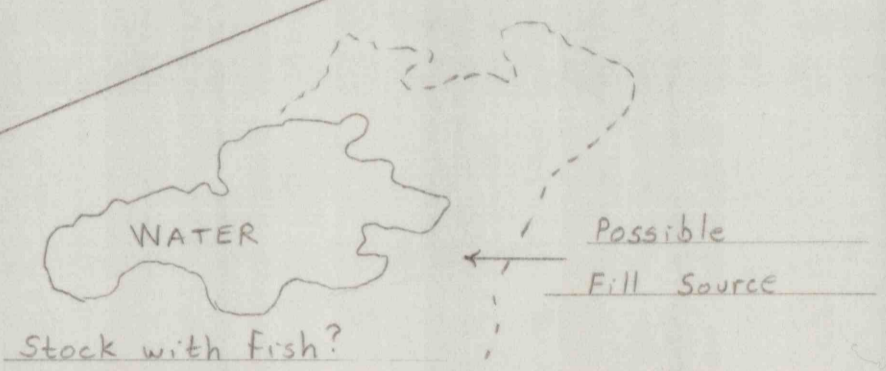
Assuming a range + facilities length of 2200 feet¹, every hundred feet of width would take about 5 acres.

If the southern tip of the property is cut off, giving the League a triangular parcel, the range parcel would take about 44 acres.

¹ League members have said a 600 yard range would be very desirable, and may be feasible. Impact/backstop area, parking, and firing line area will add to the necessary range length.
