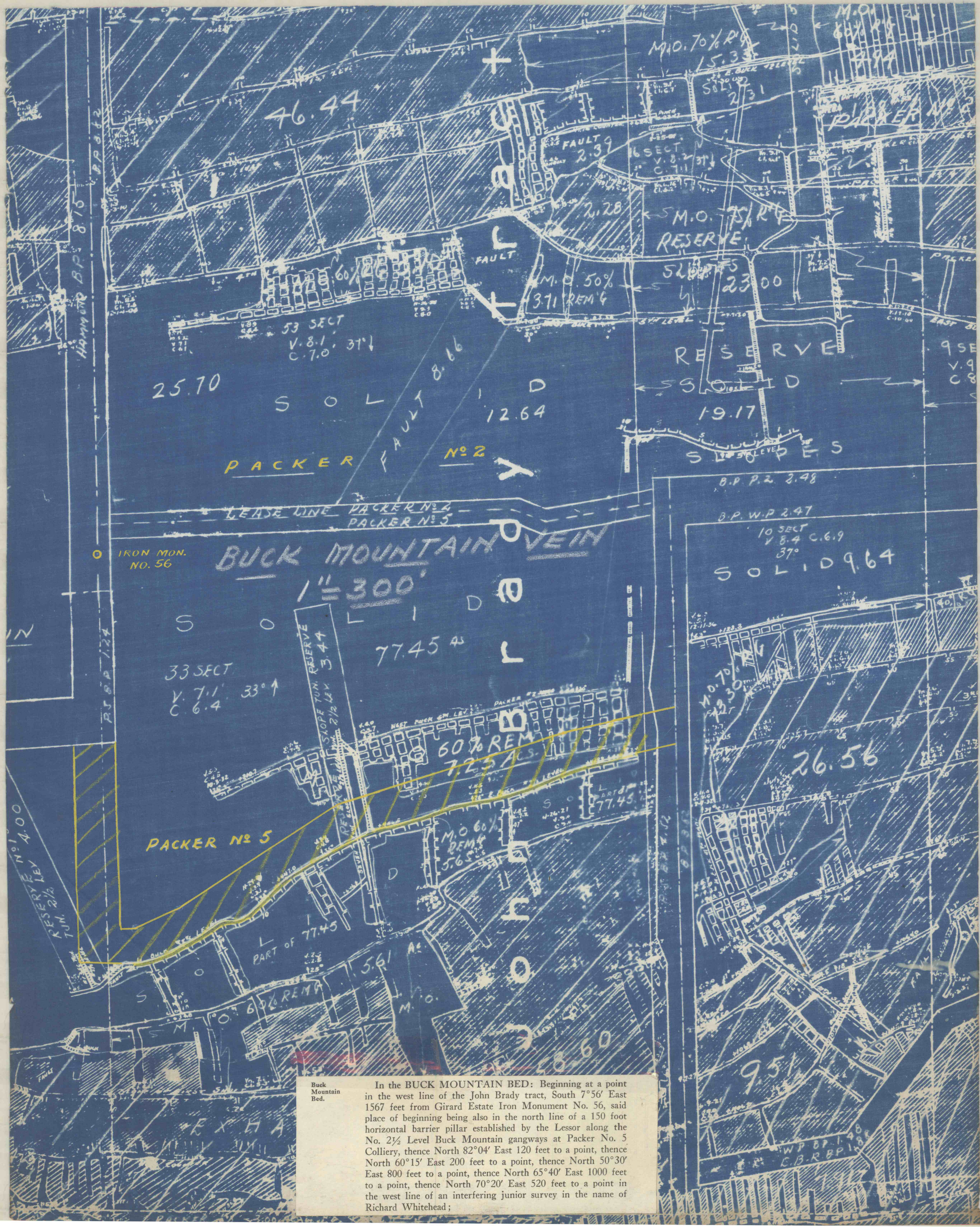




Buck Mountain Bed.

In the BUCK MOUNTAIN BED: Beginning at a point in the west line of the John Brady tract, South 7°56' East 1567 feet from Girard Estate Iron Monument No. 56, said place of beginning being also in the north line of a 150 foot horizontal barrier pillar established by the Lessor along the No. 2½ Level Buck Mountain gangways at Packer No. 5 Colliery, thence North 82°04' East 120 feet to a point, thence North 60°15' East 200 feet to a point, thence North 50°30' East 800 feet to a point, thence North 65°40' East 1000 feet to a point, thence North 70°20' East 520 feet to a point in the west line of an interfering junior survey in the name of Richard Whitehead;
