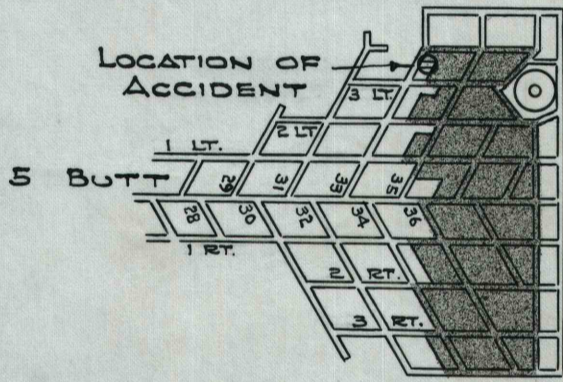


EXPLANATION:
