**EXPLANATION:**

WHILE A TRIP OF SUPPLIES WHICH CONSISTED OF 2 CARS OF CRIBBING BLOCKS AND 2 TRUCKS OF TIMBERS WAS PASSING ALONG THE HAULAGE APPROXIMATELY 124 FEET FROM 12 BUTT 10 FACE A PIECE OF SAND ROCK 8'x8'x6" WITH FEATHER EDGE BROKE LOOSE FROM THE ROOF, ONE END FELL ON TIMBER TRUCK SKIDDING ALONG TOP OF THE TIMBERS. THE FALLING ROCK TRIPPED 3 SET OF TIMBERS LEAVING THE ROCK TO FALL ON LAST CAR CRUSHING BELSKI'S CHEST AND SKULL BETWEEN CRIBBING BLOCKS AND SAND ROCK, WHICH CAUSED INSTANT DEATH.

FALL OF SAND ROCK CAME AFTER MOTOR HAD PASSED UNDER THIS AREA, STRIKING VICTIM WHO WAS SITTING ON FRONT CORNER OF CAR LOADED WITH CRIBBING BLOCK
