VICTIM - STEVE BELLICH, TIMERMEN HELPER CK. NO. 1355
 PLACE - I.A.C. 48 FACE
 TIME - 4:50 P.M. MAR. 12, 1949
 EXPLANATION - VICTIM AND BUDDIES HAD SET FOUR WOOD TIMBERS, REMOVED TWO SHORT WOOD TIMBERS, AND WERE IN THE ACT OF REMOVING THE THIRD SHORT WOOD TIMBER WHICH WAS SUPPORTED ON A TIMBER JACK. AFTER THE TWO LEGS WERE REMOVED. TWO PIECES OF COAL AND SLATE FELL FROM THE BROW OR LIP ONE PIECE STRIKING THE VICTIM ON THE BACK CAUSING DEATH.
