EXPLANATION:
 A TRIP OF 37 LOADED CARS MOVING OUTBY ON MAIN HAULAGE PARTED WHEN SWIVEL COUPLING AT LOCOMOTIVE BROKE. THE TRIP RAN INBY AND COLLIDED WITH AN EXPLOSIVE TRIP CONSISTING OF A LOCOMOTIVE, AN EMPTY CAR, A DETONATOR CAR, AN EXPLOSIVE CAR, AN EMPTY CAR, AND A LOCOMOTIVE. THE VICTIM WAS RIDING ON THE REAR LOCOMOTIVE OF THE EXPLOSIVE TRIP AND WAS FATALLY INJURED AS A RESULT OF THE COLLISION.
