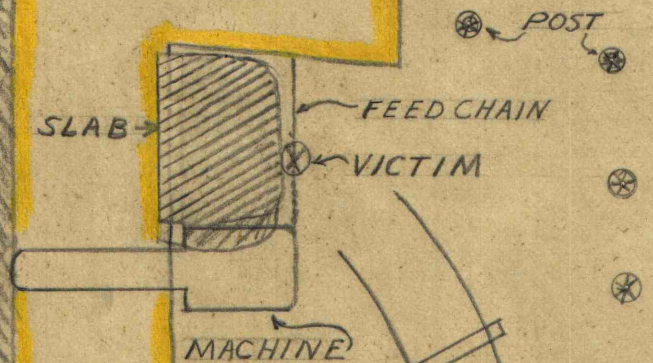


GOB AREA
