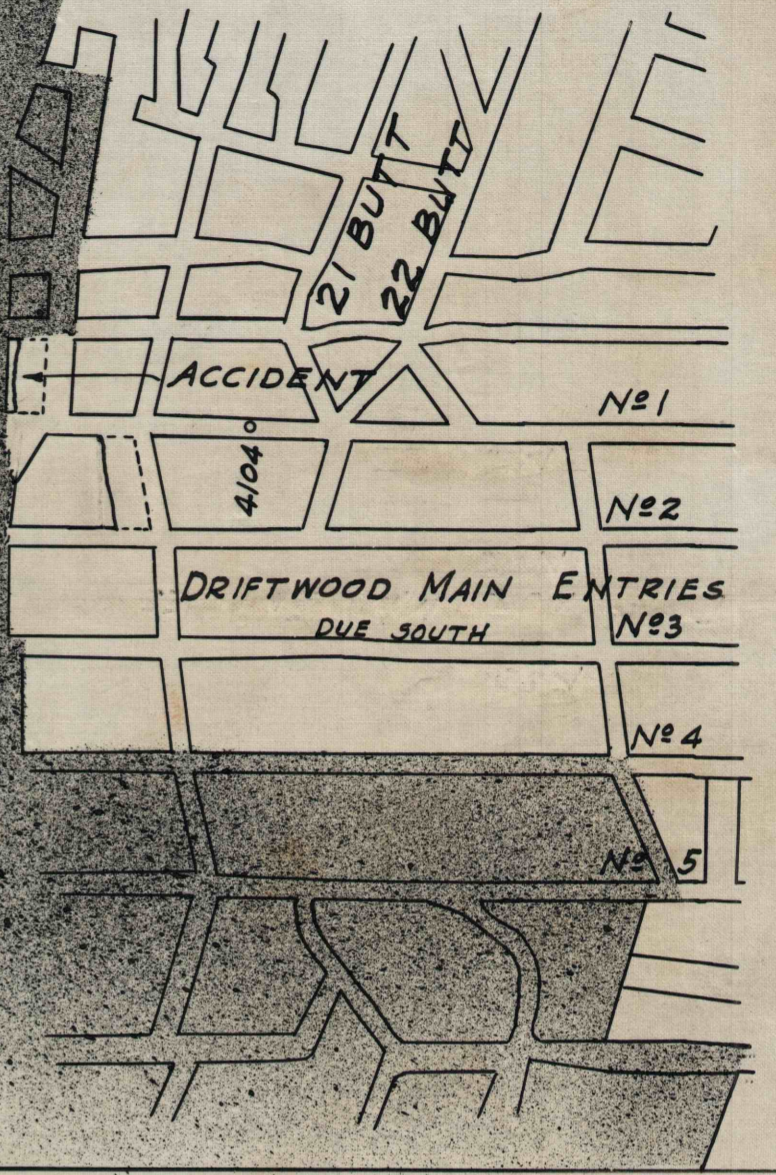

Note: The only posts shown are those which were still standing after the accident.

Victim and John Kreitner, pick miners, were loading from chain pillar stump, right side of No 1 Driftwood Main Entry, when a piece of rock, approximately 24' long, 12' wide and 4-6" thick, fell in place, crushing victim to bottom, causing instant death.
